Re: Belle Terre Litigation – Milford Hills Properties/RPL of Michigan vs. Charter Township of Milford

In regard to Case No. 2017-162642-CZ, concerning the Milford Hills litigation, Plaintiffs served the Township with its First Set of Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents, as evidenced by the attached Proof of Service (discovery requests of this nature do not need to be filed with the Court, they simply get served upon the appropriate party). The discovery requests seek the identity of witnesses and documents regarding the operation of the Ridge Valley wastewater treatment plant. The information being requested will take some time to assemble and answer, and the Township is working with legal counsel in that regard.

The Township Supervisor will be deposed by the Plaintiffs on September 17th, as indicated on the attached Re-Notice of Taking Deposition Duces Tecum of Donald Green, and Plaintiff Ray LeDuc's deposition was taken by the Township's legal counsel on August 14, 2018. No pleadings are filed with the Court in regard to deposition proceedings, they are simply part of the discovery process
