

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MILFORD
ORDINANCE NO. 156-A-119**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE III, GENERAL PROVISIONS, OF CHAPTER 19, ZONING, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MILFORD, BY ADDING SECTION 19-113, ACCELERATION, DECELERATION AND PASSING LANES, IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH ZONING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF ACCELERATION, DECELERATION AND PASSING LANES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MILFORD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment.

Article III, General Provisions, of Chapter 19, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Milford, is hereby amended to include Section 19-113, Acceleration, Deceleration and Passing Lanes, which shall read as follows:

Sec. 19-113. Acceleration, Deceleration and Passing Lanes.

Acceleration, deceleration, and passing lanes shall be required to promote the safety and convenience of both vehicular and pedestrian traffic within the site and in relation to adjoining access streets and roadways which serve the site, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Acceleration, deceleration, and passing lanes for roadways, public or private, and driveways entering on a county primary or a paved road shall be required for all development projects requiring site plan review and approval under Section 19-84. A passing lane shall not be required if a center turn lane is present or if insufficient right-of-way is available for its construction. The requirement for the installation of a passing lane may be also waived by the Planning Commission provided such waiver is first obtained by the applicant from the Road Commission of Oakland County or the Michigan Department of Transportation, as may be appropriate, prior to the review of the project by the Township.
- (2) Where required, acceleration, deceleration or passing lanes shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the standards of the Road Commission of Oakland County, the Michigan Department of Transportation, or the adopted Engineering and Design Standards of the Township, depending upon which entity has jurisdiction of the respective roadway.
- (3) Installation of acceleration, deceleration and passing lanes shall be done at time of provision of initial road or driveway approach prior to any land balancing, site improvements or building construction on site, as defined in subparagraph (1) above.

Section 2. Savings Clause.


That nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted be construed to affect any just or legal right or remedy of any character nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Severability.


The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Section 4. Adoption.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to have been adopted by the Charter Township of Milford Township Board at a meeting thereof duly called and held on the 16th day of August, 2006, and ordered to be given effect upon publication as mandated by Charter and statute.


