

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MILFORD
ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT
ORDINANCE NO. 156-A-129**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 19-82, OUTDOOR STORAGE IN RESIDENTIAL AND NONRESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS, OF ARTICLE III, GENERAL PROVISIONS, OF CHAPTER 19, ZONING, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MILFORD, IN ORDER TO DESIGNATE A NEW CAPTION FOR THE SECTION AND TO REPLACE SUBSECTION (5) WITH TEXT DIRECTED AT THE STORAGE OF VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS IN THE TOWNSHIP.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MILFORD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment.

Section 19-82, Outdoor Storage in Residential and Nonresidential Districts, of Article III, General Provisions, of Chapter 19, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Milford shall be renamed and entitled Section, 19-82, Outdoor Vehicle Storage in Residential Districts.

Section 2. Amendment.

Subsection (5) of Section 19-82, Outdoor Vehicle Storage in Residential Districts, of Article III, General Provisions, of Chapter 19, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Milford, and shall repealed in its entirety and shall be replaced with a new Subsection (5), which shall read as follows:

(5) Regulations pertaining to the storage of vehicles for the personal use of the occupants in residential zoning districts shall be in accordance with Section 19-182(6) for the R-1-R, Rural Residential District; Section 19-207(7) for the R-1-S, Suburban Residential District; Section 19-232(6) for the R-1, Single-Family Residential District; and Section 19-257(6) for the R-2, Multiple-Family Residential District.

Section 3. Savings Clause.

That nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted be construed to affect any just or legal right or remedy of any character nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability.

The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

Section 5. Adoption.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to have been adopted by the Charter Township of Milford Township Board at a meeting thereof duly called and held on the 16th day of January, 2008, and ordered to be given effect upon publication as mandated by Charter and statute.
