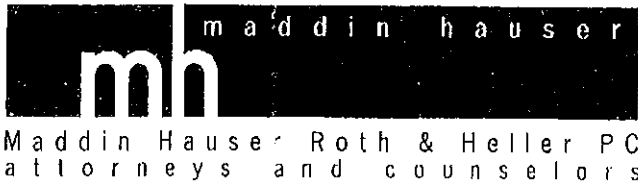

My office represents Joel Q. Hack and Wren Beaulieu-Hack. The Hacks, through my office, recently filed a lawsuit against The Charter Township of Milford, Supervisor Donald D. Green, the Milford Board, and Building Administrator Timothy C. Brandt, alleging certain violations of law, including violations of the Michigan and U.S. Constitution relating to due process violations and discrimination. For your review, I am enclosing via email the Verified Complaint, as well as an Emergency Motion relating to this dispute.

I am in receipt of your August 24, 2018 correspondence relating to 2610 Pearson Road, which recommended approval of the construction of a residential driveway at 2610 Pearson Road. I am also in receipt of your October 8, 2018 correspondence relating to 2610 Pearson Road, in which you write you were "directed" by Milford's Board to "re-review" your August 24, 2018 recommendations.

I will need to ask you a variety of questions under oath at a deposition, including, among other topics, the nature of your written and oral communications with Supervisor Green and Building Administrator Brandt, the Milford Board members, and Milford Attorney Jennifer Elowsky relating to 2610 Pearson Road, as well as the factual bases for your October 8, 2018 revisions.

As a professional courtesy, I wish to coordinate the scheduling of your deposition such that it is compatible with your other commitments. As you know, this is a time-sensitive matter given the flooding hazards caused by Milford's delays in reviewing the driveway project, and


