August Primary Election – August 7th

Applications for Absentee Voter Ballot

If you want to vote an Absentee Voter Ballot, call, 248 685-8731, or come in to our office to get an application. Once we receive your ***completed*** Absent Voter Application, you will be issued a ballot. All AV Ballots must be turned in by 8 pm on Election Day in order to be counted. All ballots (in Michigan) are counted on Election Day.
