ORDER REGARDING PENDING MOTIONS

At hearings held on July 11 and July 16, 2019, the Court heard the arguments of counsel on several pending motions, including (i) four motions *in limine* filed by Defendants, and (ii) Defendants' June 14, 2019 second motion for summary judgment. For the reasons stated on the record at these two hearings,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: (i) Defendants' June 10, 2019 motion *in limine* to preclude reference to other lawsuits or citizen complaints (Dkt. 44) is **GRANTED**; (ii) Defendants' June 10, 2019 motion *in limine* to preclude reference to liability insurance (Dkt. 45) is **GRANTED**; (iii) Defendants' June 10, 2019 motion *in limine* to preclude Plaintiffs from arguing that Defendants' actions were motivated by religious discrimination (Dkt. 46) is **GRANTED**; and (iv) Defendants' June 10, 2019 motion *in limine* to preclude Plaintiffs from arguing that the unique permitting requirement imposed upon them by the Defendant Milford Township Board is evidence of discrimination (Dkt. 47) is **DENIED**.

Next, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants' June 14, 2019 second motion for summary judgment (Dkt. 52) is **DENIED**.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
